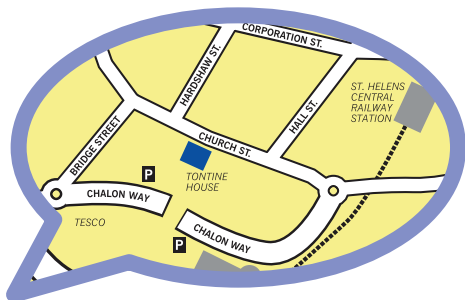

A LINK (Local Involvement Network) will give people a chance to share their views and experiences on local health and social care services. This information will be used to help change and develop services so they meet people's needs.

## Why do we need a LINK?

A LINK is an independent network which will make it easier to be heard on health and social care issues. LINKs have also been given certain powers so they can say how local services should improve.

## Why should I get involved in St Helens LINK?

Your views matter and the more people who are involved, the stronger LINK will be. Individuals, groups and organisations can become a member of LINK, but you do not have to become a member to have your say or get involved.
